We recently received a request from the Idaho Division of Environmental Quality for general guidance and/or recommendations for the development of WYNDvalley analyses for two areas in Northern Idaho. In an attempt to provide our general recommendations to a wider audience, we are attaching a copy of our response. While our recommendations by no means address all technical considerations associated with the use of WYNDvalley, we believe that they provide a good starting point for the development of analyses using the model. We have found that analyses which generally conform with the recommendations contained in the attached letter have yielded good results in the development of PM₁₀ SIPs throughout Region 10. As with any modeling analysis, additional judgements/refinements will need to be applied in the application of WYNDvalley.
