Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: Federal regulatory and policy requirements

- Uniform Grants Guidance: Code of Federal Regulations (CFR)
 - -2 CFR 200
 - » Subparts B through D: Administrative Req.
 - » Subpart E: Cost Principles
 - -2 CFR 1500





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: Minimum Organizational Administrative Requirements

- Ensure your organization meets minimum standards for
 - Financial Management Systems (2 CFR 200.302)
 - Internal Controls (2 CFR 200.303)
- Policies and procedures must be documented





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: Before you apply

Obtain a DUNS number

Register in SAM

Grants.gov





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: DUNS number

Dun & Bradstreet (D&B) provides a DUNS Number, a unique nine-digit identification number for the physical location of your business.

DUNS Numbers are required to identify organizations and track how federal grant money is allocated.

DUNS Number assignment is free for all businesses required to register with the U.S. Federal government for contracts or grants.





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: System for Award Management (SAM) registration

Entities designate an official point of contact for e-business with the federal government via SAM registration.

SAM is used by the federal government to streamline monitoring of all federal contractors and grantees.

SAM registration is free and a multi-step process that may take five business days or longer to complete.

Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements Elements of an application

Main components:

- SF 424
- SF 424A
- Budget detail (a.k.a. budget narrative)
- Workplan

Other components:

- Other documentation required by competition (e.g., resumes)
- Negotiated Indirect Cost Agreement
- Certification forms: EPA Form 4700-4, Key Contacts, EPA Form 6600-06 (>\$100,000), SF-LLL Disclosure of Lobbying Activities (if applicable)

Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: Budget Detail

- Follow federal cost principles of 2 CFR 200 Subpart F.
 Matching funds must also follow federal cost principles.
- Show your math in the Budget Detail with appropriate detail.
 - e.g., Personnel cost = 1 Biologist * \$35.25/hour * 0.3 FTE (626.4 hours/year) = \$22,081.
- All elements of Budget Detail should be reflected in Workplan.
 - e.g., Going to Boise is line item in Travel; this must be in the Workplan.





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: Cost Principles

- Allowable (2 CFR 200.403)
 - Is this cost allowed under 2 CFR 200.400-476 (Subpart E)?
- Allocable (2 CFR 200.405)
 - Is this cost allocable to the workplan?
- Reasonable (2 CFR 200.404)
 - Is the cost itself reasonable?





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements: Budget Detail

- The Budget Detail must exactly match the 424A across all cost categories (Personnel, Travel, etc.). The totals must match the SF 424 and Workplan.
- Do not include cents.





Applying for EPA Assistance Agreements Grants.gov

- Submit all forms via Grants.gov.
- Do not e mail applications forms or other information to EPA unless explicitly requested.
- You may request an exception to grants.gov submittal if you have no internet access or intermittent internet access. Submit requests to OGDWaivers@epa.gov at least 15 calendar days before your application due date.
