- 2020 season recap
 - Alaska is tracking reports of freshwater and marine HABs through engagement with tribal, federal, and other state agencies
 - Alaska has yet to document a HAB in a freshwater location that poses a recreational risk to the general public

 - Alaska has a draft response plan but needs additional engagement with other state agencies to resolve authority issues before adoption
