## Recreational/Ambient Waters Program

- 2020 season recap
  - Idaho experienced a fairly normal bloom season. COVID-19 led to budget constraints and travel limitations that limited our ability to respond to blooms and collect the number of samples we would have in years past. We don't have the basic bloom data (species and density) but the necessary health advisories were issued.
- Updates on guidance and response planning efforts
  - Currently working on internal guidance for DW staff response. Nothing new on monitoring or risk communication at this time.
- Updates on monitoring/analysis tools development
  - I am working with DEQ GIS techs to improve our potential bloom map
- Updates on risk communication tools

  - DEQ SW and DW programs have a significant number of new staff. We are working more closely with USBR to coordinate monitoring on the reservoirs managed by that agency.
