 - State & National Estuary Program funds
- Funding FY 2015-17
 - State: \$3.2 mill
 - Federal: TBD (working out budget now) (2013-15 was \$1.5 million)





- Funds for Columbia River Basin \$1.2 million (2015-17)
- \$500,000 in pass-through for local government technical assistance
