# History

- Technical assistance – Ecology + Local Govt.
  - Small businesses & SQGs
  - Dangerous waste & stormwater
- Began in 2008
  - To date, over 18,000 business visits
  - Partners as of 2015
    - 20 local govt. contracts
    - Puget Sound & Spokane Watersheds
    - State & National Estuary Program funds
- Funding FY 2015-17
  - State: \$3.2 mill
  - Federal: TBD (working out budget now) (2013-15 was \$1.5 million)

- New Directions
  - Funds for Columbia River Basin – \$1.2 million (2015-17)
  - \$500,000 in pass-through for local government technical assistance
    - Clark County & City of Vancouver interest
    - Other possibilities TBD
    - Develop partner contracts by December 2015
  - Ecology new positions to support region
    - Central Regional Office (Yakima – now Union Gap) – work directly with businesses
    - Environmental Assessment Program – monitoring pilot
