Grant activities

- 1: Initiate a monitoring scheme to estimate a baseline trophic magnification slope for the Flathead Lake food web
- 2: Evaluate the health outcomes of eating donated fish fillets (survey)
- 3: Convene half-day workshop to develop a plan that benefits human & ecosystem health



Outcomes

- Food pantries role in providing beneficial health outcomes to low income tribal members
- Baseline trophic magnification slope
- Fill critical data gap on MeHg in lake whitefish
- Community Engagement Plan
 - ? Effective communication of MeHg in Flathead Lake fish
 - ? Continued monitoring of web food
 - ? Need for additional fish consumption guidelines
