General Findings

2019 routine inspections were conducted during rain events as well as during the dry times of the summer. During the past year Seneca staff did not find any visual evidence of pollutants from our site. All control measures remained in place during the 2019 year. No replacements needed and we maintained the drains clearing any leaves, debris and brush throughout 2019. No non-compliance situations were observed for the year.

Provide a summary of your past year's quarterly visual assessment documentation (see Part 3.2.2 of the permit).

Visual assessments were conducted on the following dates: . Quarter one was taken on 2-13-19, no sample taken in the Second quarter 4-1-19 through 6-31-19, the river was very high and the storm water discharge was completely under water because of the high level of the Payette river. Third quarter was taken on 9-17-19 and Fourth quarter was taken 12-11-19.

Visual assessments were completed using a clean, clear jar and checking for odor, color, clarity, floating solids, settled solids, suspended solids, foam and oil sheen. The storm water assessments/inspections showed the sample storm water as clear, brownish/grey. There were no odors, clarity was good and some floating leaf particles were present. Settled solids consisted of sand, pebbles and some vegetation. No oil sheen was noted in any of the samples throughout the year. As shown above, our industrial activities did not have an impact on 2019 samples

Seneca had no exceedance on E. coli sampling in 2019. (E. coli sampling was requested by EPA since the received stream is impaired for E. coli.)
