General Findings

Four routine facility inspections performed in 2019 12/10,6/18/7/31 and 3/13. Drain filters were replaced early summer. A drain filter was placed at outlet a. In late winter rail unload area was in need of house cleaning. New mill management in early spring has implemented better house keeping. Berms and gravel infiltration on west side working to keep water away from facility. North side gravel infiltration working and in good condition. Gravel lot and retention area on east lot contain storm water runoff.

Two visual assessments were done along with discharge sampling. Samples tended to look cleaner than in the past. Levels of phos. and e-coli were still high. Working with our Corp. Environmental group to try and determine better methods and BMP's. Water Evaporates and infiltrates out of pond, e-coli tends to increase. Ducks use the pond.

Only Two samples for E-coli were taken in 2019 due to few discharges. Ecoli levels remain high. Not sure they can be reduced due to waterfowl use of the pond.

In the past year TSS levels were down but still above TMDL limit, TP and E-coli are high. Still trying to determine a path forward to help reduce levels. Improved housekeeping should further reduce levels of TSS and TP.
