Routine visual assessments were performed at all outfalls as required under our MSGP permit. All discharge water appeared clear and no evidence of contamination was observed at any time during 2018 while conducting the visual assessments. No evidence of scouring was observed at any outfall. No additional control measures are needed to comply with the permit requirements.

Quarterly visual assessments were performed at all outfalls as required under our MSGP permit. Discharges from all outfalls (during 1st, 2nd, and 4th quarters of 2018) were found to be of clear or slightly cloudy appearance with the absence of any odor. All discharges were found free of any oil sheen or floating solids. No probable sources of any contamination were observed during 2018. No discharge occurred during the 3rd quarter due to a typical lack of seasonal precipitation.

Corrective actions have periodically taken place when tracking of clay has occurred at the facility over the past year. Clumps of clay that fall from vehicles and equipment are found on the roadways and routinely removed. This issue has had no impact on the water quality, but has been observed after equipment operations during wet weather conditions. BMP's have been incorporated minimizing equipment usage on our clay stockpile/rock road interface during wet weather to help minimize the tracking of clay at the facility. No modifications are needed to our stormwater control measures. Our facility is in compliance with the MSGP and has had no incidents of noncompliance in 2018.
