Aluminum and iron levels were down this year, but nitrates and zinc were higher -- all benchmarks were exceeded this year. Have taken some steps to mitigate contaminant levels and are developing a plan for 2019.

Were able to collect samples on four occasions, however as is often the case, third quarter did not have suitable rain to sample. Sample v isual quality was normal with slight color, no odor, no oil sheen.

Installed a drainage ditch to divert water from south end of facility into a small detention pond; had this detention pond cleaned of growth and trash. Tried to stabilize soils around facility by planting native grass species, unfortunately, our hire landscape company sprayed thes e areas -- are trying this again in 2019, using proper signage. Installed another swale above zone A to help reduce run-off and sediment. Ongoing sweeping of plant impervious surfaces every-other-month. We are regularly exceeding the benchmark standards; have met with company management to develop a list of stormwater improvements, prioritize and fund.
