The May 10th sample had four (4) parameters over Benchmark. The facility documented/committed to complete a recap on preventative maintenance with all employees and enforce good housekeeping practices. Also, continue to relocate material to another location to help ensure material is not getting involved with the run-on stream.

The November 2nd sample had six (6) parameters over Benchmark. It came from a different outfall. Corrective action focused on concentrating on the NE Section of the Non-Ferrous Warehouse in terms of material exposure and pavement sweeping.

The facility is in compliance with it's Permit.
