General Findings

The Jerome Ready Mix Concrete Batch Plant performed inspections on a monthly basis, with a minimum quarterly inspection to serve as a back up in the event that the monthly inspections were missed. Triple C Concrete implemented the updated complianceGO web-based software in 2019. After a few months of implementation and testing, the inspection software has helped to better provide clearer documentation pertaining to corrective action items. Our routine inspections have helped us to better keep up with 55 gallon drum management, helping us to ensure that drums, mostly motor vehicle fluids, are stored properly, labeled, and removed promptly from by 3rd party service providers. Another area where the routing facility inspection helped is at the facility drainage point controls. With the bermed french drain containment swales surrounding the drainage point, storm water was observed to mainly retain on site. Routine facility inspections helped with observing when maintenance or upkeep may have been needed at bermed containment areas, and the clean out of other facility washout ponds for mixer truck operations.
